



Rockport Baptist Church Funeral and Memorial Service Fee Structure

Approved by the Board of Deacons on November 20, 2025

The Rockport Baptist Church is privileged to be able to facilitate Memorial and Funeral Services. For information on planning the service please refer to the “Preparing for the Resurrection Packet” located at FirstBaptistRockport.Org/documents.

The church does not seek to make a profit from these services but needs to cover the base costs required to produce such events. This often includes many hours of staff time in preparation for the event and in clean-up following the event. The following rates and policies exist to cover the cost of these events incurred by the church. Exemptions to these rules may be allowed in cases of financial hardship.

Base Cost Breakdown

Memorial or Funeral Service Base Cost for a services Monday – Friday = \$500

Memorial or Funeral Service on a Saturday = \$1,000

Note: No services will be allowed on Sundays. Services and Fellowship on Saturdays must be completed by 4:00 PM

Additional Cost Breakdown

Piano/Organ Player = \$300

Inclusion of Praise Team = \$500

Church staff design of a slideshow for service = \$100

Church Coordination of Fellowship Time = \$200

Coffee and Tea = Complimentary

Church Staff Design of Program = Complimentary

Livestream of service on Facebook = Complimentary

Parking

It is recommended that requests for any special parking on High Street be done in conjunction with a Funeral Home or the Town of Rockport. A limited amount of space is available in church lot.

Note on Planning Services and Black Out Dates

Services may take place at any time of the year within three weeks of death. Services that are planned for a later time of the year cannot take place during the following black-out dates: within seven days before or after Easter, May 15-31 and the entire month of July.
